# **Tackling Wildlife Crime**

JAAN continues to work closely together with the National Police Department and sister organisation WCS on tackling wildlife crime together. In 2015 alone, we have conducted 9 big confiscations leading to the arrest of 16 wildlife traders and the confiscation of both live animals as well as parts of protected wildlife. These raids also have international character and therefore we also collaborate with police departments in Europe and organisations abroad. On the last confiscation, conducted on



Thursday, 22 october, 140 Kilograms of dried seaturtle meat as well as 80 Kilograms of seaturtle shells, 90 seahorses and deer-parts were confiscated in Surabaya. JAAN continues to prioritise tackling the wildlife trade and legal enforcement in its programs.

# **Dancing Monkeys**

JAAN continues to care for almost 70 ex dancing monkeys and now a release of a third group is being prepared. These monkeys were all confiscated end 2013. The process to rehabilitate and release monkeys is long and costly. 
