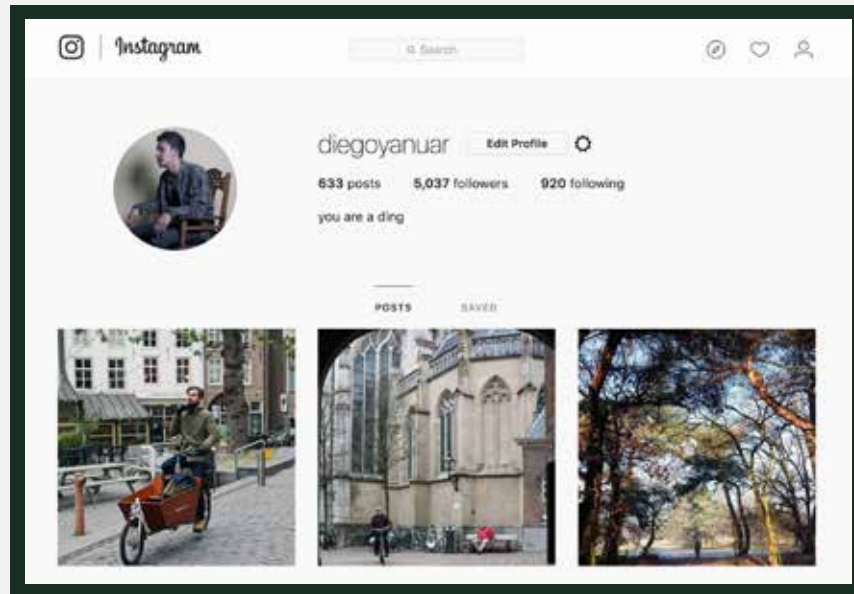

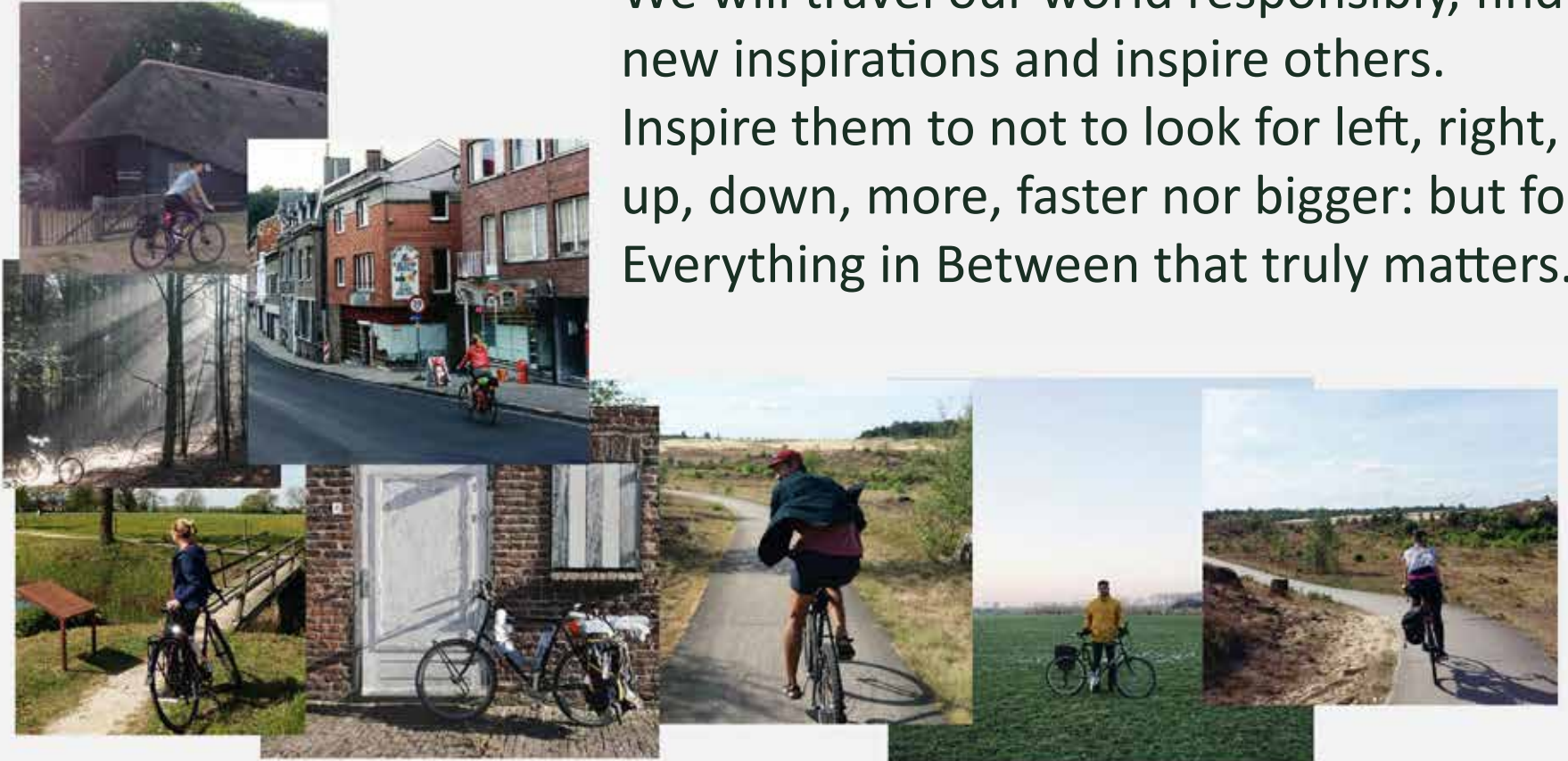


Diego makes photos and videos and Marlies writes. We are proud to have family and friends who are willing to share our adventure too.

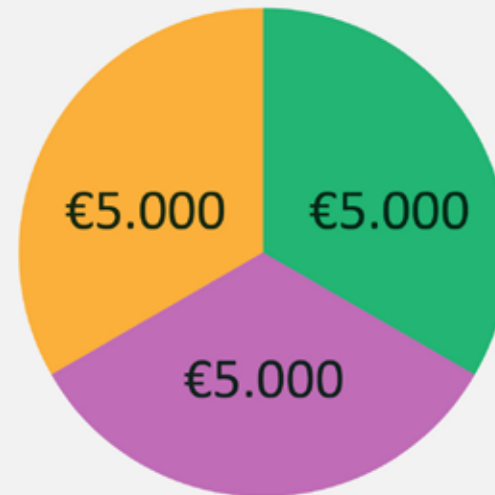
